On January 4, 2024, Viterra made a collective bargaining proposal to GSU which included retroactive pay commitments for employees in the period starting January 1, 2023. Subsequently, the membership of GSU voted in favour of the proposal and at the end of January 2024, Viterra provided increases and paid retroactive pay to some members of GSU which were covered by the proposal. Other members were not paid the increase and retroactive paid which they were owed under the proposal. This grievance claims the increases and additional amounts of retroactive pay with employees are owed under the proposal.
GSU relies upon the bargaining conduct of the parties, which along with related communications, may also constitute unfair labour practices, with various possible remedies over and above the payment of the outstanding retroactive pay. This grievance is without prejudice to any unfair labour practice application.
