2024 scholarship program

guidelines



GSU is offering five \$2,000 scholarships in 2024.

GSU is pleased to offer \$2,000 scholarships to five students who demonstrate an ability and a passion to inspire positive change in their community.

Scholarship program summary:

- Scholarships are available to all GSU members and their immediate families including spouses.
- Scholarship applicants must be enrolled in a diploma, degree, or certificate program at a community college, university, trade school, or technical institute as a full-time student in any country.
- Five \$2,000 scholarships are available:
 - three dependant scholarships, and
 - two GSU member/spouse scholarships.
- Dependant scholarships are available for dependant children of GSU members.
 Applicants for dependant scholarships must be age 25 or younger.
- GSU member scholarships are available for GSU members and spouses of members.
- If there are no member/spouse scholarship applications, all five scholarships will be available to be awarded to eligible dependant applicants.

- GSU members must have a signed union card on file with the union to be eligible for GSU scholarships.
- Students can apply every year.
- Student can receive a maximum of one scholarship per year. There is no limit to the total number of scholarships a student may receive throughout their lifetime.
- GSU's scholarship committee will meet to determine the successful scholarship recipients. The decision committee's decision is final.
- Scholarship applicants will be advised of the committee's decision by Sept. 1.

How to apply:

Complete either the dependant or the member/spouse application form and return it to Grain and General Services Union by July 1, 2024, with the following items:

- 1. A letter of recommendation from a nonfamily member describing how your participation in school, extra-curricular, and/or community activities make you a strong candidate for a GSU scholarship.
- 2. A copy of a document from your training institute which confirms your registration.
- 3. Your two-page essay. (See essay guide for additional information.)
