

GSU Dues Rebate

October 12, 2023 JEC Meeting in Regina

MOVED by Anastassia Oborotova, seconded by Howard Wilson, that this motion be tabled until the next meeting of the Joint Executive Council.

MOVED by Sheila Tran, seconded by Anastassia Oborotova that we do a cost and outline of what a \$50-per-year-minimum dues rebate and three-year cost rollover would be and report back to next Joint Executive Council.

Carried.

Report on motion

Budget in 2023 was \$12,000 for dues rebate.

- To set a minimum of \$50 per Sub-Local or Local this would increase the budget by \$300.
 It affects 11 Sub-Local or Locals.
- To set a minimum of \$100 per Sub-Local or Local this would increase the budget by \$1500.
 It affects 22 Sub-Local or Locals.

With the budget for 2024 set at \$24,000, doubling the amount to \$2/member/day.

- o To set a minimum of \$50 per Sub-Local or Local this would increase the budget by \$0.
- To set a minimum of \$100 per Sub-Local or Local this would increase the budget by \$1200.
 It affects 11 Sub-Local or Locals.

Recommendation

To increase the dues rebate to \$2/member/month and set a minimum annual amount available for each Sub-Local and Local at \$100.
