Rate the Candidate's Answers



Ask your candidates these questions to gauge their support for working people.

1. **We need leaders who will prioritize health and safety in the workplace, ensuring all workers are protected.**



- Should some workers be exempt from WCB (Workers Compensation Board) protections at work?
- Not all working people in Saskatchewan have paid sick leave. Do you think all working people should have paid sick leave?

2. **Collective bargaining is a balanced and fair process of negotiation (wages, benefits, working conditions) between workers and their employers.**



- Do you support collective bargaining?
- During strikes or lockouts, the government can order the workers back to work and restrict the members' right to strike. Do you support Back to Work legislation?

3. **Public policy that strengthens social welfare programs and ensures economic fairness for everyone is important.**



- In Canada, many workers and their families are left in a dangerous place if their employer goes bankrupt and they lose most or all of their pension. Do you think pension plans should be protected if the company goes bankrupt?
- The Federal government is working to provide universal Pharmacare for Canadians. Do you support this move for Pharmacare?



Collective Power



- Where do you stand on improving and supporting the rights of workers to join a union?



- The above can be done by card check certification that balances the overwhelming power employers have as workers vote to join a union. Do you support card check certification of new bargaining units?
